Creating a more welcoming Sacred Space: The Vestry and I have been in conversation about the possibility of removing three of the front pews on the south side of the church. This would align the south side with the north side of the nave, where other front pews have already been removed. This would give us greater flexibility in how we use the nave for different liturgical settings, while also creating a welcoming space with a rug where our youngest children can be present, play, and feel that they too belong in our worshiping community. Many Episcopal churches have created similar spaces for children within the nave, and we would like to explore how this might work at St. Luke's ~ San Lucas. At this point, no final decision has been made. Before moving forward, the Vestry and I would like to hear from members of the congregation and consider your ideas, questions, and concerns. After receiving this feedback, Vestry and I will continue the conversation and determine the best way forward. As we care for and shape our sacred space together, our hope is to preserve its beauty and reverence while making it more welcoming, flexible, and accessible to people of all ages.
